



 Apply a few drops or light spray on skin. **DO NOT** spray in enclosed areas. Avoid breathing a spray product and do not use it near food. **DO NOT** use as a space spray. Rub evenly over exposed area if needed. For ticks and chiggers, also apply to shoe tops, socks, and around openings in outer clothing. **NEVER** use repellents over cuts, wounds, or irritated skin. Repellents should be applied only to exposed skin and/or clothing as directed on this product label.
